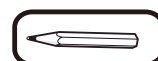

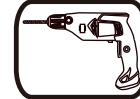

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

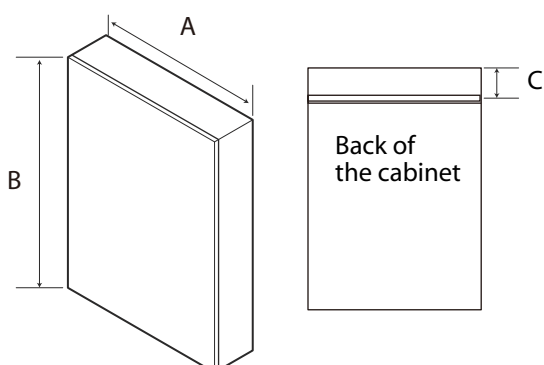
1. THIS PRODUCT MUST BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE INSTALLATION CODE BY A PERSON FAMILIAR WITH THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE PRODUCT AND THE HAZARDS INVOLVED.
2. ENSURE THE SCREWS AND WALL PLUGS ARE SUITABLE FOR THE WALL INTENDED TO MOUNT THIS PRODUCT. CONSULT THE QUALIFIED PERSON FOR SAFETY INSTALLATION.
3. CONNECT THE GROUND WIRE (BARE COPPER OR GREEN) FROM YOUR FIXTURE TO THE GROUND WIRE (BARE COPPER OR GREEN) OR GROUND SCREW IN THE ELECTRICAL BOX.
4. CLEAN GLASS WITH WATER ONLY.
5. FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY.
6. **WARNING** - RISK OF TIP OVER. MAX. 12 LB LOAD.
- DANGER** - TO REDUCE THE RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK:
7. TURN OFF ELECTRICAL POWER BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION OF THIS FIXTURE.

9. TO CLEAN THE MEDICINE CABINET, TURN OFF THE POWER, WAIT FOR IT TO COOL. WIPE THE MIRROR WITH A CLEAN AND SOFT CLOTH.

INSTALLATION:

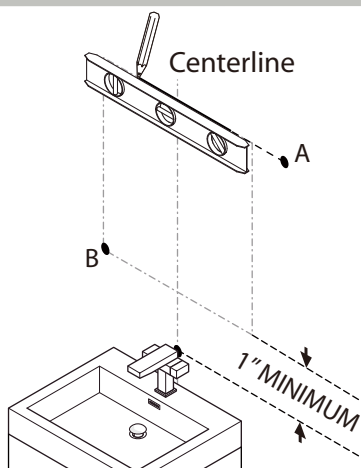
Step 1



Measure cabinet's width and height as shown.

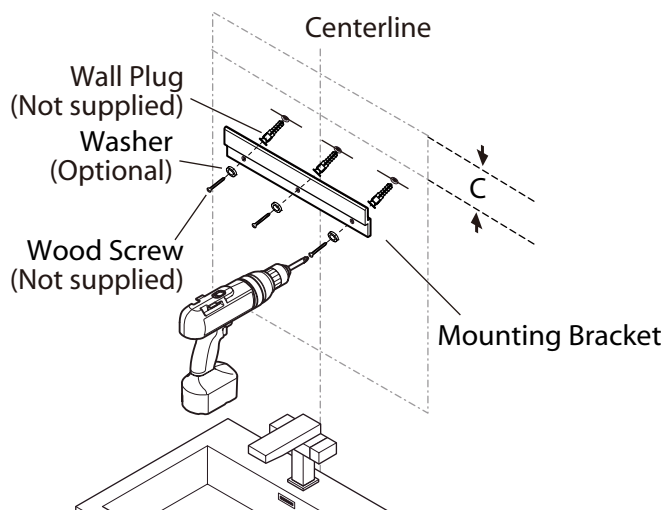
A - Width
B - Height
C - Distance of between the mounting
bracket and the top of the cabinet

Step 2



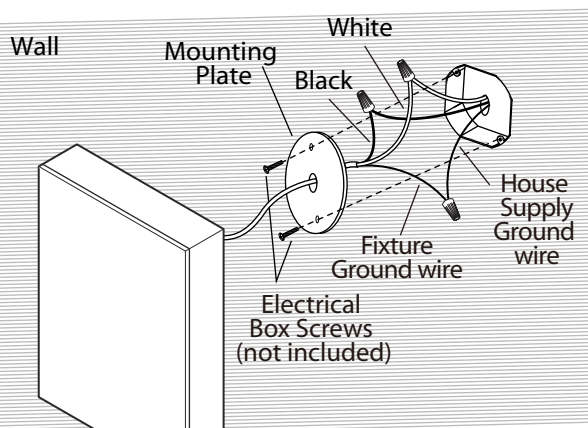
Transfer cabinet's dimensions to the wall as shown with the bottom being a minimum 1" above tap height. (using a level as shown)

Step 3



Using a level, draw a line for the distance C down from the top of cabinet line. Place mounting bracket's top edge against line and mark 3 -screw locations, drill pilot hole. (use wood screws, washer as optional and/or wall plugs as required). ENSURE THE SCREWS AND WALL PLUGS ARE SUITABLE FOR THE WALL INTENDED TO MOUNT THIS PRODUCT. CONSULT THE QUALIFIED PERSON FOR SAFETY INSTALLATION.

Step 4



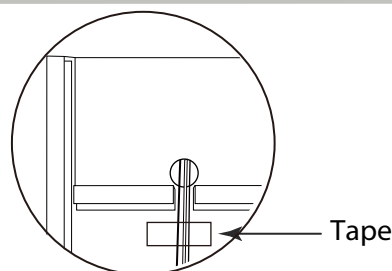
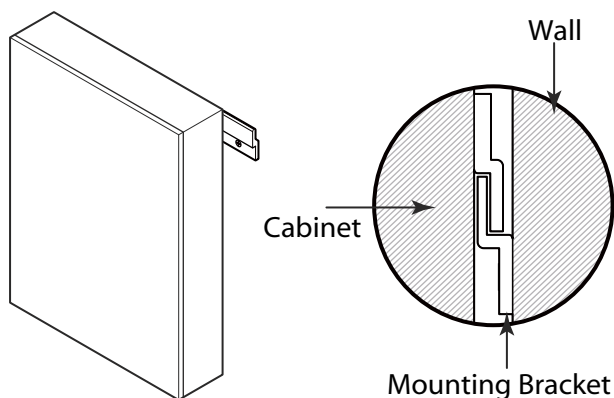
Run the fixture supply wire through the middle hole of round mounting plate. Then make the electrical connection from the cabinet to the house supply wires.

Connect the ground wires (bare copper or green) from your fixture to the ground wire (bare copper or green) or ground screw in the electrical box. Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black wire in the electrical box and connect the white wire to the white wire in the electrical box.

Once connections of wires are completed, carefully tuck wires and wire nuts into the electrical box making sure no bare wire (on the black and white) is visible at the wire nuts.

Secure the round mounting plate to electrical box using electrical box screws (not supplied).

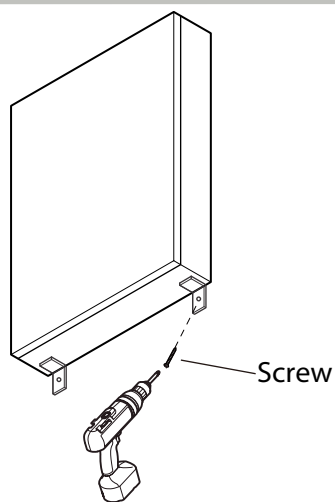
Step 5



If the bracket is below the wiring hole. Tape the wire so that it won't come out from the mounting bracket.

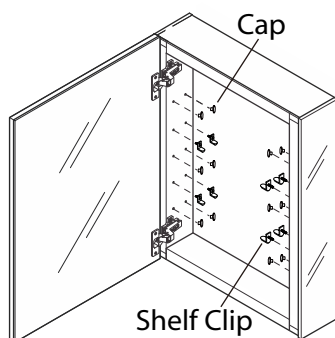
Hang the cabinet on the mounting bracket.

Step 6



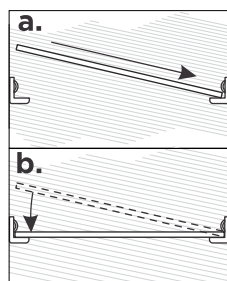
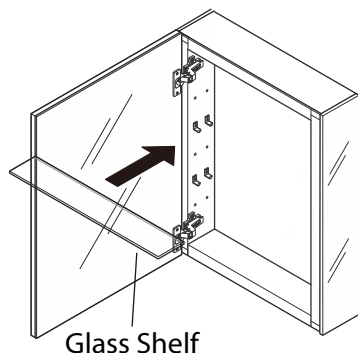
Attach 2 mounting brackets to the wall by screws and/or wall plugs as required. ENSURE THE SCREWS AND WALL PLUGS ARE SUITABLE FOR THE WALL INTENDED TO MOUNT THIS PRODUCT. CONSULT THE QUALIFIED PERSON FOR SAFETY INSTALLATION.

Step 7



Choose the position for your shelves, then insert the shelf clips into holes on the sides of the cabinet. Cover the rest of holes with the caps.

Step 8



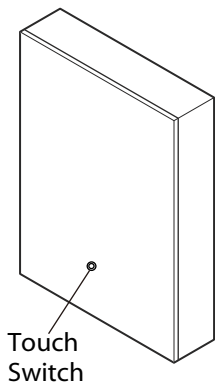
Install the glass shelf to the cabinet.

a. Push a side of the glass shelf into the left or the right pins.

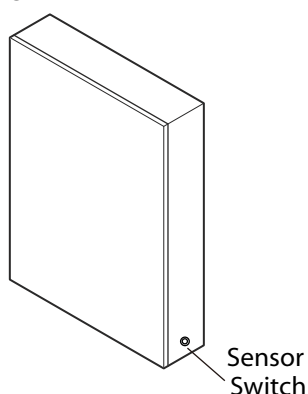
b. Snap the glass shelf into the oppsite side.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS - Optional for some models

Lighting is turned on/off by the touch switch or sensor switch.
DO NOT leave on for prolonged periods of time.

MEMORY SWITCH - Optional for some models

If connected to a wall switch and the mirror is in the on position, you can turn the mirror on and off at the wall switch.
